Significance of Award: An award presented to individuals or groups who are committed to being an exemplary role model and leader in implementing the state's initiatives for responsible environmental stewardship.

Objectives: To honor and recognize those individuals or groups whom develop and implement sustainability initiatives that minimize the unwanted impacts on environmental quality and the use of natural resources that are a product of daily activities, operations and projects in the workplace.

Award Criteria: Accomplishments in the area of environmental sustainability to include:

- a) Development and implementation of an innovative or existing sustainability practice in the workplace which has measurable results and that preserves natural resources, conserves energy, eliminates waste and/or emissions, and/or lessens overall environmental impact.
- b) Has insured that other employees have access to environmental education relating to the project and its implementation and has worked to expand their initiative into other areas.
